MAA has several exhibits each year and most are held online (virtually) at the same time. We have single-medium exhibits at Manchester Town Hall year-round showcasing members work in specific mediums. Every spring, we hold an exhibit featuring all mediums at Town Hall. Once a year, members can participate in an exhibit judged by a professional artist at the South Windsor Public Library. Monthly, we feature "Art of the Month" where winners are chosen from a pool of submitted art. These pieces are shown at Manchester Libraries and The Arbors for the entire month.

WHERE WE ARE

Our monthly meetings are a chance for people to come together and watch a demonstration by a guest artist. Meetings are held the 3rd Thursday of the month, from 7 pm to 9 pm, September through May at the Manchester Church of Christ, 595 Tolland Tpke, Manchester EXCEPT for January and February when meetings are held virtually. Regular emails provide Zoom links, if applicable, and meeting location information.

Weekly, MAA hosts Open Studio where artists can work and create alongside each other. Open Studio is held almost every Wednesday from 10 am to 4 pm at the Manchester Church of Christ (see address above). It is "open" to the public – e.g. MAA members and non-members alike.
