- **You may enter up to two works of art, not more than 22 inches on any side including frame, or enter one larger work.** The large glass shelves by the doorway are also available for three-dimensional works of art.
- Items submitted **must be original work done solely by the artist.** All media accepted.
- Please attach a note to the back of each piece with your name and the name of the artwork.
- Artwork must be securely framed and ready to hang with D-rings or screw eyes and wire (no tooth hooks or staples). Inappropriately framed works are subject to refusal.
- See Framing guidelines at <https://www.manchesterart.org/member-info> MAA reserves the right to reject any entry upon submission if it's not properly framed.
- Interested buyers will be referred to you. A price list with artists' phone numbers will be at the library circulation desk.
