Opening: Co-president Doris Phillips opened the meeting by welcoming all present, including the scholarship winners and their parents. She called for an approval vote of the April minutes that was given. She also referred to a soon to be released MAA Member Survey as a useful tool for the organization going forward and hoped that all would respond.

Vote: Doris turned the meeting over to Jim Oliphant who presented the new slate of Officers and Board Members for the 2025-2026 year. He called for a "show of hands vote" of those who had not already voted on line. The new Board, Officers, and committees were approved, among them Jim Oliphant who will be copresident with Doris. Doris thanked the current Board for their dedication.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer's report was given by Sue Massé. She stated that the Anniversary fundraiser brought in \$2,671 for the Scholarship fund. She thanked Carolyn Emerson, Carolyn Gimbrone, Eric Vogel, and Chris Larson (all past presidents) for their valuable work to make the 75th Anniversary Celebration a success.

There is currently \$18,227.60 in the checking account.

Sue Massé informed us that 80% of our income comes through *online* purchases, whether it be membership or workshops, etc. This online income is subject to a small fee for processing. For example, if our membership fee of \$35 is paid online, MAA only receives about \$32. In order to compensate for the loss of income we would like to offer the option of members paying that additional processing fee charged by the credit card companies. This change to the website will be made by Chris Larson over the summer.

Membership: Carolyn Gimbrone and Karen Waggoner reported #99 members with an additional #2 being our high school scholarship winners. Note that membership runs through August.

Exhibits: Janet Heller announced that the current Town Hall show - Spring Into Summer - will be open until August 14th at which time the Oil and Acrylic Show will be hung.
