WHO WE ARE

The Manchester Art Association (MAA) is a not-for-profit 501 c(3) organization of artists and crafters who share a love of art. Founded in 1950, We have approximately 100 members in and around Manchester, CT.

WHAT WE DO

HOW WE DO IT

Our monthly meetings are a chance for people to come together and watch a demonstration by a guest artist. Meetings are held the 3rd Wednesday of the month, September through May. Currently, meetings are being held virtually, via Zoom, which gives us a chance to see artists work up-close. Regular emails provide the Zoom links and meeting information.

Hopefully, soon, we will be able to meet safely in-person and will announce the location at that time. When this happens, we will also return to our weekly Open Studio where artists can work and create alongside each other. We have been hosting virtual workshops in different mediums – pastel, watercolor, photography, etc. Stay tuned to the Manchester Art Association website for more information as to time, days and dates as gathering in person becomes a safe option.

HOW YOU CAN BECOME A MEMBER

Individual membership in MAA is \$35 per year. Family membership is \$45 and students can join for \$20; there is no charge for members under 18 years old. During this time, we are holding virtual exhibits – some are even juried and some themed. Check out MAA online to view these exhibits. When we meet in person, we have single-medium exhibits at Manchester Town Hall year-round that showcase members working in specific mediums. Every spring, we hold an exhibit featuring all mediums at Town Hall. We also have an ongoing exhibit at Manchester Memorial Hospital. Once a year, members can participate in an exhibit judged by a professional artist at the South Windsor Public Library. We hope to return to these live exhibits soon.
